What is the Law Enforcement Foundation of Barron County?

The Law Enforcement Foundation of Barron County, founded in 2009, is an independent, non-profit, charitable organization dedicated to fostering public safety through community building, education, and outreach. In concert with area police departments, the foundation works with a range of community safety advocates to develop and implement public safety and crime prevention programs.

The Award:

The Law Enforcement Foundation will award a Scholarship of **\$500** to selected Applicants who are planning on attending post-secondary education for a career in Criminal Justice/Law Enforcement. Scholarship recipients are selected by the members of the Law Enforcement Foundation of Barron County Governance Board.

You are eligible for this scholarship if you meet the following criteria:

- You are currently a High School Senior in Barron County
- You will be attending post-secondary education next year either at a 4-year University or 2 Year Vocational/Technical and majoring in police science, criminal justice, or a law enforcement-related field.

How to Apply:

- Complete the following Application.
- Attach 2 Letters of Recommendation (sources may not include family)
- Attach a typed-up essay not to exceed 300 words on the following subject: ***Why have you chosen to enter into Law Enforcement? How do you plan to use your post-secondary education to make a positive contribution to the community you chose to live in?***
