

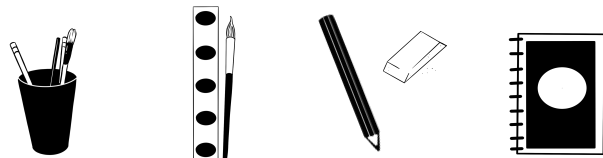

Discussions, critiques, presentations, independent work time

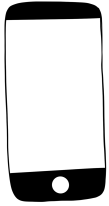
CLEAN UP

Phones go in the phone holder at start of class. NO phones in class for any reason.

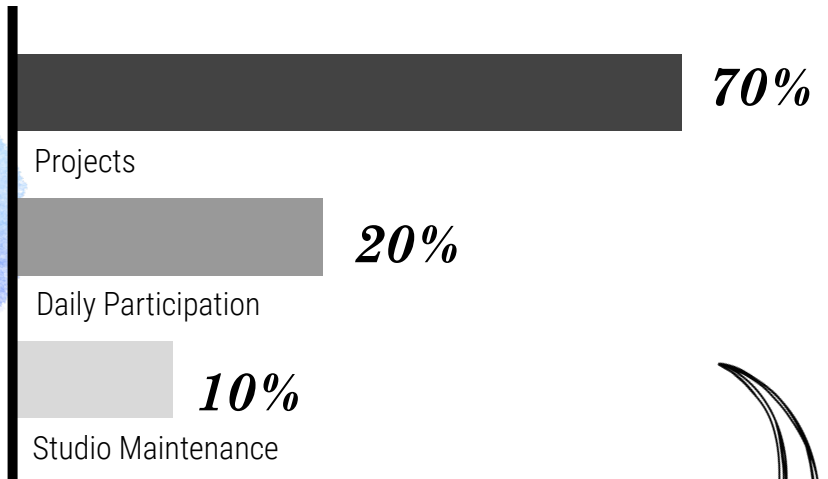
Chromebooks are only out if Mrs. Gislason has asked you to get them out, if you need an image Mrs. Gislason will help you.
