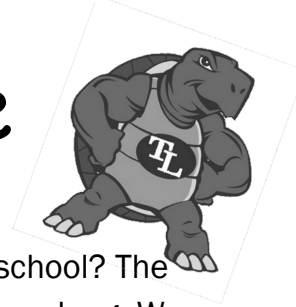


# 2023 Summer Reading Challenge



Going to be Kindergarten—1st Grade

Did you know that when kids read over the summer they are more likely to leap ahead when they return to school? The Turtle Lake Teachers have made it a priority to keep your child's skills sharp by encouraging them to read all summer long. We challenge every student that attends Turtle Lake School to read 50 books or 960 minutes over the entire summer. Every student that completes this challenge will be rewarded with a party at the beginning of next school year.

To accomplish this challenge, it means reading a book 4 days a week or reading for 20 minutes for 4 days a week. However, to challenge you even more, anyone who reads 69 books or 1,440 minutes (120 minutes a week or 30 minutes/4 days a week) over the entire summer will be rewarded with 3 pizza certificates, and anyone who reads 88 books (a book a day) or 2880 minutes (240 minutes a week or 60 minutes/4 days a week) over the summer will be rewarded with the previous 2 and a certificate for our next Book Fair in October. ## Rules:

Read books every day!

You may count up to 60 minutes of reading per day!

Log reading minutes/books on the paper with a star/smiley face. (Log sheet can also be found on Ms. Fall's school website).

Students going into Kindergarten and first grade may be read to.

Logging sheets will be due by Friday, September 1st so that awards and a party can be planned for all students who meet the goal!!
